The prize pool will be averaged in case of a tie. Example: If 3 people tie for 2nd place, the payout for positions 2, 3 & 4 will be added together and divided by 3.

Each Pro Golfer will earn points for each individual tournament. Points are awarded based on the official order of finish according to the PGA website. In case of a tie, each golfer will receive the amount of points for that position.

1st=20pts, 2nd=17pts, 3rd=14pts, 4th=11pts, 5th=8pts, 6th=5pts, 7th=4pts, 8th=3pts, 9th=2pts, 10th=1pt.



Double points will be awarded for 5 weekends:

- The Masters - April 8 thru April 11
- The US Open - June 17 thru June 20
- The British Open - July 15 thru July 18
- The PGA Championship - August 12- August 15
- The Tour Championship - Sept. 23 thru Sept. 26

We'll count all the PGA tournaments from The Bob Hope Classic (Jan. 20 - 24, 2010) to The Tour Championship (Sep. 23 - 26, 2010) even if there are more than one on a weekend. Only individually scored tournaments will count - no match play or team play events will count. Event dates may be subject to change, so please consult the PGA schedule for details.
