MAIN POOL RULES

Teams will earn two points for each game won. In case of a tie game, each team will be awarded one point. All points are doubled on a double point weekend.



Double points will be awarded for 4 weekends:
 All games played on Sep 27 & 28 (Week 3)
 All games played on Nov 19, 22 & Nov 23 (Week 11)
Divisional Playoffs on Jan 16 & 17, 2010
 Super Bowl XLIV on Feb 7, 2010

All regular, playoff & Super Bowl games count. Actual payout will be determined by the number of entries.

We will pay the top 5% of all the entries plus last place. Example - if there are 1000 entries, then the top 50 people (not positions) will be paid. We will use an averaged payout system, and in case of a tie, the prize pool will be averaged among the winners for each position. Players must verify their entries for accuracy. Prizes must be claimed within one year of the Super Bowl, and all winners are responsible for contacting the administrator.

BONUS POOL RULES

You must be entered in the Main Pool to play in the optional Bonus Pool. Your picks and points earned are the same as in the Main Pool, and the Bonus Pools will be limited to groups of approximately 200 entries. Additional Bonus Pools will be created as needed, with a similar amount in each, and there could be less than 200 in each pool. Entries will be placed in the Bonus Pool on a first come first served basis, and if you have more than one entry, you will be placed in different Bonus Pools (if available) unless you request otherwise. Payouts will be for 1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th, 5th and last place - and ties will share the amount for that spot. Payouts will be determined by the total number of entries. Payouts will be shared, not averaged, in the Bonus Pool. **We'll donate 5% of the amount collected in the Bonus Pool to the Jimmy Fund - the favorite charity of the Boston Red Sox.**
